
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TRANSMISSION MEDIA Optical Fibers

- First generation fibers (multimode, step index)
 - two materials
 - · diameter: 200 micron
- Second generation fibers (multimode, graded index)
 - about 50 layers of different silica types
 - diameter: 50 micron
- Third generation fibers (single mode)
 - · diameter: 9 micron





Human hair diameter: 100 micron



The manufacturing process









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THE NEED FOR COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT



- Sound is attenuated by transmission media (air)
- Communications equipment is needed to:
 - Solve the distance problem
 - Route the signals to their correct destination

- 1960s - ARPANET - packet switching project in US.






- 1970s - ARPANET grew to support many organizations related to US Department of Defense, US Government and research institutions.





- 1985 US National Science Foundation (NSF) creates
 5 national supercomputer centers, to be
 available to universities in US.
 - NSF connects the 5 sites with 56 Kbps lines and allows universities to connect to this network for the original purpose of having access to the 5 super computers.
 - Soon users discovered that the connections may be used for e-mail, file transfer and other services, not related to the 5 supercomputers.

- Born on November 9, 1913 in Vienna,
 Austria, as Hedwig Eva Maria KIESLER
- Studies acting and dreams of becoming a movie star
- At 17 (in 1930) she becomes a star! She is the first woman to appear nude in a major motion film: the Czech film titled "Ecstasy".
- The film is banned at the time in US!
- Married in 1933 to Austrian armament manufacturer Fritz MANDL
- Proud of his gorgeous and famous wife,
 Mandl takes her to all his business
 meetings; she entertains and . . . listens
 carefully and learns a lot.
- She personally meets Hitler and Mussolini
- In 1937 she dramatically escapes her pro-Nazi husband, making her way to London, then to US, where she is offered a contract by MGM Studiosn and asked to change her name to Hedy LAMARR.
